2004 UK International Meeting

The West Country Friday 2nd – Sunday 4th July 2004

Prices and details have now been finalised

Our base will be the Marriott Hotel, Swindon (www.marriott.com). The programme will begin at 10am on Friday and finish after lunch on Sunday, and will include visits to some of the region's attractions both historic and modern. Activities will include for the first time a Treasure Hunt around the Wiltshire countryside on Friday afternoon, as well as the usual mix of driving, socialising, eating, drinking and entertainment. For football fans, timings should allow you to watch the Euro 2004 final on Sunday evening!

Various cost options are available as follows - prices include all meals and visits as well as accommodation:

- OPTION 1 Arrive Friday morning by 10am, full programme leaving Sunday after lunch (approx 3pm). £170 per person twin/double; £220 per person single.
- OPTION 2 Arrive Friday evening (meeting at the hotel in time for dinner), leaving Sunday after lunch. £155 per person twin/double; £205 per person single.
- OPTION 3 Arrive Saturday morning by 10am, leaving Sunday after lunch. £105 per person twin/double; £130 single.

For those arriving early, we have an option on rooms at the hotel for **Thursday night** at a cost of £35 per person twin/double and £55 for a single room for Bed and Breakfast (lower than last year!). No specific dinner arrangements have been made for Thursday evening, but dinner will be taken in a private room at the hotel on both Friday and Saturday evening.

Due to the hotel's cancellation policy, bookings must be made as soon as possible together with a non-refundable deposit of £50 per person. Full payment is required by the end of April 2004.

For UK members, payment should be by cheque made payable to "barchetta UK Owners Club", and sent to Rosemary Kind, 2 Heron Road, Barrow upon Soar, Leicestershire, LE12 8AS.

For overseas visitors wishing to join in the Meeting, payment can be made either by transfer in Sterling into the UK Club account OR by credit card. Please contact rosemary.kind@virgin.net for details.





All technical projects have a "spanner rating", ranging from one (simplest) to five (scariest).

There's been a lot of discussion recently about flooded hood wells and the problems of sealing them.

Ian Barnett offers a simple solution ...

Repair Tonneau Gasket

PARTS REQUIRED

Spanner Rating:



Rubber Gasket - Part No. 46734683 (current UK price approx. £80).

TOOLS REQUIRED

• Duck tape or rubber repair kit.

SYMPTOMS AND SOLUTIONS

The rubber gasket which stops water getting into the roof storage area can, over time, become torn by the action of raising and lowering the roof. This means that the roof storage area can fill with water if the car is left outdoors, particularly if it is parked nose-downwards on a slope and water cannot drain away naturally through the small slot by the boot-lid lock. Water collection can lead to problems with mildew in the car if it is unused for any length of time.

To stop water getting into the roof storage area you can either replace the tonneau gasket or simply repair it.

Undo the roof lock handles (as if you were lowering the roof) and push up the front of the roof. This will allow you to open the tonneau cover. Once the tonneau cover is open, gently lower the rear of the roof so that it hangs above the roof storage area. Examine the gasket for any signs of wear, in particular the area between the boot lid seam and the doors, where there is a gully for water to drain away. Make sure that you examine both sides of the gasket for holes and damage (see photo, below left).

Place tape or repair patch over any holes (see photo, below right).






Any water should drain down the gully to the drain hole just behind the seat belt mounting. The start and end points of the gully are marked by the yellow circles in the pictures below.



When you close the tonneau cover it will locate in the top of the gasket and form a waterproof seal.







Gentlemen, please forgive the personal question, but are your nuts rusty?

(Ladies, please forgive the sexist nature of the query).

At many of the meetings I have attended, even the most pristine of barchettas is often let down by rusting wheel nuts. This seems to be a general problem on many Fiats, not just the barchetta.

Fear not, if you want your pride and joy to look "the mutt's nuts" there is a simple solution to curing your little boat's rusty nuts.

Allow a full day for this task.

Go to your local hardware store (or even Halfords) and buy a small can of silver Hammerite in smooth finish **not** hammered finish – this will set you back less than a fiver. Also buy a small can of Hammerite paint thinners / brush cleaner which you will need when you have finished painting.

Next, take four empty beer bottles (if they're full, just drink the contents first!) which most people should have lying around the house (or in the dustbin).

Take one rusty wheel nut from each wheel, clean off any loose rust and dirt using sandpaper, and place in the neck of each beer bottle. It's then a simple job to totally paint the head of each of the four wheel nuts with the Hammerite – I suggest using two coats on each nut. Allow the Hammerite to thoroughly dry between coats and before replacing back on the wheel and tightening up with the wheel brace.

Repeat until all wheel nuts have been painted.

As an added bonus, the Hammerite silver is an excellent match for the colour of the standard 8 hole Fiat alloys fitted to many barchettas.
